Electric Underblanket

Important safety instructions

READ CAREFULLY AND STORE FOR FUTURE USE.

- This appliance may be used by children 8 years of age and older and by persons with physical or mental impairments or by inexperienced persons, if they are properly supervised or have been informed about how to use the appliance in a safe manner and understand the potential dangers. Children must not play with the appliance. Cleaning and maintenance performed by the user must not be performed by unsupervised children.
- If the power cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service technician or by a similarly qualified person, as this will prevent a dangerous situation from arising.
- Important instructions. Store for future reference.
- This is an **underblanket**. Every time you use the electric underblanket, please make sure that it is properly spread and folded out.
- Only use the electric blanket with the control unit supplied with the appliance or recommended by the manufacturer. Under no condition should a different control unit type be used.
- When not using the electric underblanket, clean it according to the instructions in chapter «Maintenance and cleaning» and store the electric underblanket out of children's reach in an enclosed and well ventilated location away from sources of heat.
- Before storing the product, make sure that it has cooled down completely and that the power cord
 is disconnected from the power socket.
- Do not place any items on the product.
- Inspect the appliance frequently for signs of damage or wear. In the event that such signs do appear, or if the appliance was incorrectly used, return it to the supplier without any further use.
- This appliance is not designed medical use in hospitals.
- Do not use the appliance when it is wet.
- This appliance must not be used by persons unable to sense heat and by other handicapped persons unable to react to overheating.
- Children under three years of age must not use this appliance because they are unable to react to overheating.
- This appliance must not be used by children older than three years of age unless the control devices
 are set by the parent or caretaker, or unless the child was sufficiently instructed about how to safely
 use the device.



Read this user's manual.



Do not insert pins or any other items into the product.



The product is not suitable for children 3 years of age and younger.



The product may only be washed by hand. The product must not be washed in a washing machine.



Do not use folded over or crumpled.



Only use the product inside of buildings.



The product must not be bleached.



The product must not be dried in a drum dryer.



The product must not be ironed. Steaming is forbidden.

The product must not be dry cleaned.

- Carefully unpack the appliance and take care not to throw away any part of the packaging before
 you find all the parts of the appliance.
- This product must not be used by persons (including children) with physical or mental impairments or by inexperienced persons, unless properly trained or schooled in the safe use of the product, or unless they have been properly supervised by a qualified person who will be responsible for their safety.

- Under no circumstances should you try to repair or modify the product on your own danger of electrical shock! Entrust all repairs and adjustments to a specialised company/service.
- Tampering with the product during the warranty period may void the warranty.
- Never use the product if you have wet hands or feet.
- Do not use the product with your shoes on. Before using the product, always remove your shoes.
- The electrical and magnetic field emitted by the product may interfere with pacemakers. Before using, consult your doctor.
- Only store and use the product away from flammable or volatile materials and solutions.
- Keep the product away from extreme temperatures, direct sunlight and excessive humidity. Do not use in an overly dusty environment.
- Do not place the product near heaters, open fires or other appliances or equipment that are sources
 of heat.
- This appliance is designed for household use. Do not use it in industrial surroundings or outdoors!
- The product must not be used as a mat for household pets. There is a risk of it being bitten to pieces and injury by electrical shock with the possible consequence of the animal's death.
- Do not use the product for purposes other than those intended.
- Before connecting the product to a power socket, ensure that the voltage on the rating label is the same as that in your power socket.
- Do not place the power cord near hot surfaces or over sharp objects. Do not place heavy objects on the power cord. Position the power cord so that it will not be stepped on or tripped over. Make sure the power cord is not touching a hot surface.
- Do not disconnect the power cord from a power socket by pulling on the cord.
- Do not spray the product with water or any other liquid. Do not submerge the product in water or any other liquid during operation.
- Never use the product near a bathtub, wash basin or any other container filled with water.
- When not using the product, or when not planning to use it, turn it off and disconnect the power cord from the power socket. Prior to cleaning, proceed in the same manner.
- Never leave the product switched on without supervision.
- Be especially careful when the product is used near children. Always keep the product out of children's reach. Children must be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the product.
- Do not use the product for indoor heating purposes.
- Do not place the product underneath mattresses.
- Do not place large or heavy items such as luggage, etc. on the product.
- Ensure that the switch is not covered by blankets, pillows or similar objects and that it is easily accessible.
- Do not fold, bend or scrunch up the product during operation.
- Do not use the electric underblanket on adjustable position beds. If you do use it on an adjustable
 position bed then ensure that the underblanket is not bent or that its power cord is not caught or
 twisted somewhere.



WARNING!

The user should not fall asleep while using the appliance.

- Only use the product as a heating underlay. Do not roll up the underblanket and do not wrap yourself in it.
- In the event of long term use or when using overnight, set the control unit only to level "1".
- Do not set the switch to a higher level for long term or overnight use.

User's manual

- Prior to using this appliance, please read the user's manual thoroughly, even in cases, when one
 has already familiarised themselves with previous use of similar types of appliances. Only use
 the appliance in the manner described in this user's manual. Keep this user's manual in a safe
 place where it can be easily retrieved for future use.
- We recommend saving the original cardboard box, packaging material, purchase receipt and responsibility statement of the vendor or warranty card for at least the duration of the legal liability for unsatisfactory performance or quality. In the event of transportation, we recommend that you pack the appliance in the original box from the manufacturer.

DESCRIPTION OF THE APPLIANCE

A1 Electric underblanket A3 Temperature control unit

A2 Display A4 Power cord

BEFORE FIRST USE

• Make sure that the product is in no way damaged before first use.

CONTROLS

- Unfold the electric underblanket at the location where you will be using it and ensure that it
 is not folded over or bent and that the power cord with the control unit is at the top section
 nearer to your head. Check that the electric underblanket is really flat and even. Every time
 you use the electric underblanket, please make sure that it is properly spread and folded out.
- Unwind the power cord. Insert the power plug into a power socket.
- Using the control unit **A3**, set the desired temperature intensity. You may select from the following settings: 0 = off, 1 = low temperature, 2 = medium temperature, 3 = high temperature. The corresponding number will be shown on the display **A3**.
- The product will start producing heat and will reach the set heat intensity after approx. 15 minutes. Please remember that certain parts of the body are more sensitive to heat than hands.
- We recommend setting a high temperature, and after heating up, to adjust the temperature to a lower level as required.
- The product will automatically turn itself off after 3 hours of continuous operation. This is a safety mechanism that protects the product against overheating. If you need to keep the product on longer, set the control unit A3 to position 0, wait approximately 10 seconds and then use the control unit A3 to set the temperature intensity again.
- When not using the product, set the control unit A3 to position 0 and disconnect the power plug from the power socket.



Note:

The product may emit a slight odour when first turned on. This is normal.



Attention:

In the event of long term use or when using overnight, set the control unit only to level "1". Do not set the switch to a higher level for long term or overnight use.

If the electric underblanket is turned on, the switch may be a little warm, so for this reason it must not be covered during operation.

When used, the electric underblanket must be covered by for example a blanket, otherwise heat losses will be too high and the underblanket will not heat up sufficiently.

Only use the electric underblanket with the supplied control unit. Under no condition attempt to modify the product.



WARNING:

The electric underblanket must be fully rolled out and unfolded before use. Otherwise there is a risk of its irreparable damage.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

- Before cleaning the product, set the control unit A3 to position 0 and disconnect the power plug from the power socket. Wait until the product cools down completely.
- Small stains can be removed using a rag or a damp sponge dipped in lukewarm water. Larger stains can be removed by washing.

Washing procedure:

- First disconnect the underblanket from the power cord by pulling the safety upwards.
- Wash by hand at a max. temperature of 30 °C.
- After washing, thoroughly rinse the underblanket in lukewarm water.
- Do not wring the electric underblanket or spin-dry in a drum clothes dryer. Loosely place the underblanket on a clothes line and allow it to dry naturally.



Attention:

Never wash the electric underblanket together with the power cord!

Do not use fans or other appliances for drying, allow the underblanket to dry naturally in the air.

Never dry the electric underblanket by turning it on!



WARNING:

To prevent a dangerous situation, fire or injury by electric shock from arising, do not submerge the control unit **A3** or the power cord in water or any other liquid.

STORAGE

- Before storing the product, make sure that it has cooled down completely and that the power cord is disconnected from the power socket.
- Do not place any items on the product.
- Store the product out of children's reach in a closed and well-ventilated location away from sources of heat.
